

2011- 2012 CIF Boys Lacrosse Season at THHS

The 2011-2012 Trabuco Hills Boys Lacrosse season rollout. Congratulations to the 2011 Sea View League Champions and welcome back to another season. The coaching staff for this years team is looking for dedicated, motivated and team spirited student athletes to fill 3 squads (Varsity, Junior Varsity and Frosh / Soph), with the goal to repeat as League champions and to compete for a CIF playoff spot.

Player / Parent Registration: Scheduled for **November 9, 2011** (7:00pm - 9:00pm) in the THHS MPR. Registration night will include: Player registration, player contribution installment payments, 2012 game day program sales materials, spirit wear pre sales and parent volunteer signup. At the Mandatory January Team Kick-Off meeting, the team will collect remaining Player contributions, SVUSD transportation payment, additional spirit wear orders, and finalize any remaining paperwork required for season.

Player Registration: Complete signup roster and submit completed player enrollment forms: 1) Blue Athletic Clearance Form 2) White Emergency Card 3) SVUSD Transportation Form 4) Medical Clearance Form (good for 12 months).

**Players may not participate in team affiliated practices and workouts without complete submission of all forms.

A Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 is required entering and must be maintained during season. The Guidance Dept. will publish eligibility at the beginning of season, during mid term and will recheck eligibility of players prior to CIF Championships. Players that have utilized there one time waiver will not get eligibility until GPA is 2.0 or higher. The one time Waiver is the only option available during a student's year tenure.

Player Dues: All Player base contributions for this season are \$475.00 and will be adjusted according to player status and squad placement. All returning players will receive new dry fit shirt, shorts and socks and may receive a new Jacket or sweatshirt if moved up from a squad from the previous year. Contribution payments will be established under an installment plan, commencing at registration November 9, 2011 of \$275.00, second installment of \$200 00 due December 9, 2011 and the remaining balance (pending squad placement and team gear requirements) due early to mid January (TBD), 2012 at the "Team Kickoff Meeting". Team will collect two post dated checks at the registration meeting on November 9th.

New Incoming Players Payment Plan: New Incoming player's contributions are \$675.00. This includes an incoming team Spirit pack – THHS Lacrosse Bag with Lifetime Warranty, Logo shirt, practice shorts and socks, Game Day Polo and Team Logo Jacket. New Incoming players will pay \$275(11/9/11), \$200(12/9/11), \$200(1/9/12) installments on the assigned dates. Incoming players can write three post dated checks and turn them in at the November 9th meeting.

SVUSD Transportation fee: Each player is required to pay the allotted transportation fee of \$75.00, made payable to 'SVUSD', for the Boy's Lacrosse Season. Contributions may be reduced based on multi sport player or multi student options. Transportation fee schedules will be provided at player registration. Note: This fee is tax deductible and necessary for all official scheduled away events and games. Under SVUSD Policy, your child must ride the bus both ways under supervision of SVUSD employee/Coach. You cannot drive your son and drop off/and or pick up from away games. Transportation exemptions may be obtained at the A.D> office and submitted one week in advance. Transportation contributions will be made at the January team Kickoff meeting or can be turned in at the November 9th meeting.

Fundraising: THHS Lacrosse conducts fundraising events pre-season and through-out the season, providing funding for: coaching stipends, referees, field support expenses, travel, on field safety trainers, equipment and team events. THHS Lacrosse fundraising does provide a **"play for free"** advertising sponsorship option which allows players and families whose ad sales exceed their contributions obtain a credit up to the amount of their contribution. As an incentive, a 1:2 sales ratio will apply (\$1.00 credit for \$2.00 sold) . This incentive is in effect until February 10, 2012. Protected sponsor rosters will be published at registration (11/9) in the Program Ad sales

packet. Protected sponsor retention will have a sales commitment deadline of January 6, 2012. **Notification of protected sponsor transfer to an alternative player to be issued to: mmckahan@cox.net

Parent Volunteers: Parent volunteers support the lacrosse program, players and coaching staff throughout the entire year and pave the way for student athletes to focus on education and on field performance. Every graduating class also graduates experienced parent volunteer positions that need to be filled to continue building a strong Boys Lacrosse program. Volunteer positions and signups will be presented at Player/Parent Registration night.

Spirit Wear: Team Spirit Gear orders will be available at Player Registration. Player and fan gear proceeds support the program and make a great holiday gift. January meeting will require players to show up and try on spirit pack game day wear.

Squad Evaluations: For the benefit of the Players, they are recommended to attend all camp session to learn and keep their lacrosse skill levels up. To help the Coach to evaluate your player's skill level, it is highly recommended that they attend all Camp Sessions established by the team. **Official Tryout** open for all players will be conducted on **December 5th – 7th (time and Location TBD)**. Squad placements for Varsity, JV and Frosh/Soph will be finalized shortly thereafter.

Season Schedule: Practices will begin mid January to early February.
Season starts: February 28, 2012.

Tournaments: Tournaments are a great team building experience and an opportunity to play teams outside the league and increase team skills. THHS will host the 3rd Annual Orange County Classic – January 14-15, 2012. Additional local tournaments are being reviewed for scheduling. THHS Varsity (boys and girls squads) will participate in the annual 241 Classic to be held at THHS on February 11th. Tickets will be sold and issued to THHS families to support this fundraising event.
